



Use esta tarjeta durante un encuentro con oficiales de inmigración



Usted tiene derechos constitucionales:

- **NO ABRA LA PUERTA** si un agente de inmigración está tocando la puerta.
- **NO CONTESTE NINGUNA PREGUNTA** de un agente de inmigración si trata de hablar con usted. Usted tiene el derecho a guardar silencio.
- **NO FIRME NADA** antes de hablar con su abogado. Usted tiene el derecho de hablar con un abogado.
- Si usted está fuera de su casa, pregúntele al agente si tiene la libertad de irse y si le dice que sí, vágase con tranquilidad.
- **ENTRÉGUELE ESTA TARJETA EL AGENTE.** Si usted está dentro de su casa, muestre la tarjeta por la ventana o pásela debajo de la puerta.

I do not wish to speak with you, answer your questions, or sign or hand you any documents based on my 5th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution. I do not give you permission to enter my home based on my 4th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution unless you have a warrant to enter, signed by a judge or magistrate with my name on it that you slide under the door. I do not give you permission to search any of my belongings based on my 4th Amendment rights. I choose to exercise my constitutional rights. These cards are available to citizens and noncitizens alike.



Use this card during an encounter with Immigration officials



You have constitutional rights:

- DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR if an immigration agent is knocking on the door.
- DO NOT ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS from an immigration agent if they try to talk to you. You have the right to remain silent.
- DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING without first speaking to a lawyer. You have the right to speak with a lawyer.
- If you are outside of your home, ask the agent if you are free to leave and if they say yes, leave calmly.
- GIVE THIS CARD TO THE AGENT. If you are inside of your home, show the card through the window or slide it under the door.

Você tem direitos constitucionais:

- NÃO ABRA A PORTA se um(a) agente dos serviços de imigração estiver a bater-lhe à porta.
- NÃO RESPONDA A NENHUMA PERGUNTA dos agentes dos serviços de imigração se tentarem falar consigo. Tem o direito de permanecer em silêncio.
- NÃO ASSINE NADA sem falar primeiro com um advogado. Tem o direito de falar com um advogado.
- Se estiver fora de sua casa, pergunte ao(à) agente se é livre de se ir embora e, se ele(a) disser que sim, abandone calmamente o local.
- ENTREGUE ESTE CARTÃO AO(À) AGENTE. Se estiver no interior de sua casa, mostre o cartão através da janela ou passe-o por baixo da porta.
